Even the most land locked schools can participate as test tanks can easily be made from readily available industrial sized guttering.

Popular delivery methods include: club activities (e.g Young Engineers), curriculum projects or a combination of both, open day events, one day challenges, primary links schemes, or even staff training day activities etc etc !!

**Formula Sun** is tailored to fit engineering curriculum requirements enabling both individual projects and team delivery to take place side by side. This gives considerable scope for a context when pupils carry out work that requires them to engage with employers as part of their course.

Teams compete in four rounds:

- Hull design & manufacture
- Powertrain
- Teamwork
- Racing

Starter kits are inexpensive and key components are recyclable from group to group. The scale of the boats makes it an ideal CAD CAM project, and in this respect we are supported by Techsoft UK who can supply both kits and CAD CAM advice.

Once registered you will receive an information pack containing a host of materials and entry to regional race day events. The annual finals will be held at the prestigious London International Boat Show in January.
